### **December 20, 2017**

On December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 the Gananoque Police were conducting a RIDE program within the Town of Gananoque. At approximately 9:26 pm police observed a sedan travelling westbound on King Street West that did not have rear lights illuminated. The vehicle was noted by police to be the subject of a previous complaint regarding the registered owner habitually driving while impaired.

Police investigated the vehicle and the lone male occupant. The man exhibited signs of having consumed alcohol and as a result was given a Roadside Screening test, which the man failed. The man was arrested and transported to the police station, where tests were conducted that determined the man had a blood alcohol concentration that was double the legal limit.

A 57-year-old Gananoque man was subsequently charged with Impaired Operation and Operation of a Motor Vehicle while over 80 milligrams. The man was released to appear in court at a later date.
