On December 20, 2018 the Gananoque Police Service arrested a 21-year-old Prescott male on an outstanding arrest warrant from a shoplifting incident from an east end business in Gananoque. The male was identified as the accused from an incident in September 2018 where the male entered the business and stole a \$599.99 hoverboard and fled the business. The male was identified on CCTV video footage and was eventually located, arrested and held in custody pending a bail hearing in Brockville Court.

On December 20, 2018 the Gananoque Police Service arrested a 49-year-old Amherstview male for failing to attend court. The male had been out on release conditions from a previous break and enter related offence and failed to attend court for his scheduled court date. The male was located and brought into custody and is scheduled to answer to the charges in Brockville Court.

On December 20, 2018 the Gananoque Police Service was contacted regarding a concern for the wellbeing for a male who was observed to be falling and extremely intoxicated in the east end of Gananoque. Officers located the male who exhibited signs of extreme intoxication. The 47-year-old Gananoque male was arrested and charged under the Liquor Licence Act for being intoxicated in a public place and held in custody till sober.

On December 20, 2018 the Gananoque Police Service responded to two separate Mental Health related calls. In each occurrence the males were apprehended under the Mental Health Act due to concerns for their safety and wellbeing. They were transported to hospital, where they received medical treatment and admitted into hospital care.
