### **December 29, 2018**

#### Youth Probation violations

In the early morning hours of December 29<sup>th</sup>, the Gananoque Police responded to a dispute at a King Street East residence. Officers entered the residence and spoke to a male and female inside. The female lied to officers about her identity as she was on probation with a condition not to communicate with the male. The female left the residence before officers became aware.

The female was located a short time later and was arrested. The 16-year-old Kingston female was charged with one count of obstructing a peace officer and three counts of failing to comply with the conditions of her probation order. She was released and will appear in court at a later date.

#### Domestic Violence Arrest

The Gananoque Police received a report of domestic violence that had occurred several weeks prior. A subsequent investigation resulted in a 29-year-old Gananoque man being arrested and charged with one count of domestic assault and one count of uttering threats to damage property. The man was held in custody pending a bail hearing.

### **December 31, 2018**

#### Assault with a Weapon

Gananoque Police were called to Charles Street South residence to a report of an assault. Police attended and found that the parties were still on scene. Subsequent investigation revealed that a female suspect attended the residence to locate her boyfriend and a disturbance ensued between the suspect and her boyfriend's family. The suspect struck a female victim several times with an umbrella causing minor injuries to the victim's head.

An 18-year-old Gananoque female was arrested for assault with a weapon and was released to appear in court at a later time.
