October 25th, 2018

Officers of the Gananoque Police Service were called to a north end residence to a report of damage caused to a motor vehicle. Officers were alerted to a suspect, who was known to the victim and who was reported to have left the residence in distress. Officers located the male a short time later and arrested him for the offence of mischief. He was assessed by officers on scene and found to be suffering from mental health issues and as a result he was taken to hospital for further assessment.

The 23-year-old Gananoque male will appear in court at a later date for the offence of mischief.

October 26th, 2018

In the early morning hours of October 26th, the Gananoque Police were called to a southward residence to a report of an assault and threats. Officers attended and determined that a 31-year-old Gananoque male had attended his neighbor's residence and assaulted the neighbor and threatened to harm them further. The male was located and arrested without incident. He was charged with assault, uttering threats and one count of failing to comply with a condition of his probation order. The male was held in custody pending a bail hearing.

The Gananoque Police arrested a 27-year-old Gananoque male who had a warrant outstanding for two counts of possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose and three counts of failing to comply with his probation order. The charges stem from an incident investigated on August 31st, 2018. The male was held in custody pending a bail hearing.
