October 5, 2018

On October 5, 2018 officers with The Gananoque Police Service arrested and charged a 42-year-old Gananoque male with failing to comply with conditions of his probation order. The accused had been placed on probation to not have contact with his ex-common law wife and 2 children due to a previous incident that resulted in the probation order being placed on the accused. The accused was placed on the probation order in mid-September and on October 4, 2018 the accused communicated with the 3 individuals in a public place for an extended period of time. Police were notified, and the contact was confirmed. The accused was held in custody pending a bail hearing.

October 6, 2018

On October 6, 2018 at 3:48PM the Gananoque Police Service, Gananoque Fire Department and Leeds and Grenville EMS attended to the intersection of James Street and North Street, Gananoque as a result of a 2-motor vehicle collision. It was determined each vehicle had one occupant the lone driver. 1 driver was treated for minor injuries at Kingston General Hospital and released. The second driver was treated for serious non-life-threatening injuries and remains in hospital care receiving treatment. As a result of the investigation a 20-year-old Gananoque male was arrested and charged with:

- Dangerous Operation of Motor Vehicle Cause Bodily Harm - Section 249(3) CC
- Exceed 80 Milligrams Blood Alcohol Content/Motor Vehicle/with Bodily Harm, - Section 255(2.1) CC
- Driving While Ability Impaired Cause Bodily Harm/Motor Vehicle/Alcohol - Section 255(2) CC

The accused was held in custody to attend bail court.
