The Gananoque Police arrested a 33-year-old female who had warrants for various property offences and two counts of failing to attend court. The female was initially located and arrested by Kingston Police, who turned her over to Gananoque Police for processing.

The female was kept in custody pending a bail hearing.

Late Saturday evening the Gananoque Police were called to a west end business to a report of a male who was intoxicated and had been arguing with his family. Police attended and found the male had causing some damage to the property and had become confrontational with his family.

The 26-year-old from out of province was arrested for breaching the peace and was held until he was sober and then released without charges.

September 2, 2018

Early Sunday morning, the Gananoque Police, while on patrol observed a lone male who appeared to be sleeping on a bench along King Street East. Officers spoke to the male who had urinated on the sidewalk and was found to be extremely intoxicated. The male did not have any companions to look after him, and as a result the 38-year-old man was arrested for his own safety. He was kept in custody until sober and released after being served a ticket for being intoxicated in a public place.
