On April 8, 2021, the Gananoque Police Service received a call for a possible impaired driver. Upon police investigation it was revealed that a domestic incident had initially occurred, resulting in the male damaging property before leaving the residence. The male was located and arrested on the domestic related charge. Further investigation revealed an odour of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the male's breath. Male was required to provide a breath sample, which registered more than two times over the legal limit. The 31-year-old male from Gananoque was charged with Mischief, Operate Conveyance while Impaired, and Operate Conveyance with over 80mgs and is scheduled to appear in court at a later date. His driver's license was automatically suspended for 90 days and his vehicle impounded for 7 days.
