### Media Release

#### April 17, 2021

Yesterday the Ontario Government announced new emergency orders to help limit the spread of Covid-19 that came into effect on April 17, 2021 at 12:01AM. We await clarity and direction of the newly announced orders. The Gananoque Police Service will continue to engage, explain, educate, and where appropriate enforce, but we will not be doing random stops of people or vehicles. We continue to recognize that we must have public trust.

#### April 13, 2021

On April 13, 2021 at approx. 10:45PM officers while routine patrol observed a known male in the passenger seat of a motor vehicle that was known to be on a curfew and was to be within their residence at the given time. The male is also currently before the courts on 2 separate drug related charges for trafficking and possession of cocaine. The male was subsequently arrested for failing to comply with his curfew and upon further search was in possession of cocaine. As a result, the 23-year-old male from Gananoque was charged with failing to comply with his release order X 2, possession of cocaine and held in custody pending a bail hearing.
