### August 02, 2021

On August 02, 2021, at approximately 03:38 hrs, officers of the Gananoque Police Service entered into an investigation after receiving reports of a driver intentionally driving his truck onto a recently painted "Pride" flag on the roadway at the corner of Park St. at King St. and spinning his tires with the intent to cause damage to the painted flag. The flag had recently been repainted after a similar incident occurred just over one week prior. The investigation revealed, with the assistance of the public, that the person responsible was a 21-year-old male from Lansdowne. On August 03, 2021, the male agreed to turn himself in to the Gananoque Police and was taken into police custody and subsequently charged under the Criminal Code with Mischief Under \$5000. Additionally, the male was charged under the Highway Traffic Act for Stunt Driving, his driver's licence was suspended for 30 days, and his vehicle towed and impounded for 14 days. The male is to appear in Court at a later date to answer to both charges.

### July 29, 2021

On July 29, 2021, officers of the Gananoque Police Service received a call regarding a suspected break and enter at the Gananoque U-Lock Storage facility. Officers attended and located break in tools and items that led officers to approximately 35 Storage Units that had been entered. The individuals whose lockers were entered were contacted and officers learned that a number of items had been stolen, in particular, a large quantity of metal that was to be recycled. The investigation led officers to identify an involved vehicle that was registered to a Kingston male, who, through video surveillance was identified as the driver of the vehicle used in the offence. On August 04<sup>th</sup> an arrest warrant was sought for the male who was arrested a short time later. The 31-year-old male from Kingston is charged with Break and Enter, Theft, Possession of Property Under \$5000 and Fail to Comply with Release Order. He was held in custody and is to be held for a show cause hearing.
