MEDIA RELEASE

August 5th, 2021

On August 5th, 2021, The Gananoque Police Service received a report of a missing Youth. The Gananoque Police began a missing person investigation and with the assistance of multiple agencies located the Youth in Oakville, Ontario on August 8. The Youth was currently on a Release Order with a condition to only reside at an approved address. The Youth was transported back to Gananoque Police Service where he was held for a bail hearing for breaching a Release Order.

August 5th, 2021

On August 5th, 2021, The Gananoque Police responded to a report of an assault. Police investigation revealed that a Youth had punched and kicked two adult victims and had to be restrained. While the Youth was restrained awaiting police arrival the Youth made threats stating he would hack their heads off and that he would also take the guns off police then shoot the two victims and police. Police arrested the Youth and during the investigation located a homemade sword that had a wooden handle with a 12" metal saw blade. The Youth was charged with two counts of Assault, two counts of Utter Threats and one count of Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose.

August 7th, 2021

On August 7th, 2021, at approximately 3:20am The Gananoque Police Service responded to a report of youths yelling in the area of the 300 block of Brock St. Officers located a group of youths and observed one of the males place an object down that sounded like glass. Officer observed the object to be a bottle of alcohol. The youth who placed the bottle down was unsteady on his feet and displayed multiple signs of being impaired by alcohol. The youth became argumentative with officers and was placed under arrest as a result of being in contravention of the Liquor Licence Act. The parent of the Youth was contacted so that the youth could be released from police custody. The Youth was charged with Being Intoxicated in a Public Place and Person Under 19 years Having Liquor.

August 10th, 2021

On August 10th, 2021, A 46yr old Male from Loyalist Township attended the Gananoque Police Service to turn himself in on an outstanding Bench Warrant for Failing to Attend Court. The male was arrested and then released on another Court date.
