MEDIA RELEASE

August 13th, 2021

- 1) On Friday August 13th, 2021, Gananoque Police investigated a 42yr old male from Kenmore, Ontario who had a two-and-a-half-foot braided rope with a steel ball attached to the end. It was attached to the handlebar of his motorcycle with a quick release function. This device is known as the “get back whip” and is intended as a weapon of opportunity and has no function for the operation of a motorcycle. As a result, the male was charged with Weapon: Possession for a Dangerous Purpose and will subsequently appear in Court.
- 2) On Friday August 13th, 2021, Gananoque Police while on patrol observed a 41yr old male from Tweed, Ontario and a 55yr old male from Deseronto, Ontario walking on King Street with open containers of liquor. Subsequently both males were charged under the Liquor License Act for Having Liquor in Open Container other then Licensed Premise, Residence or Private Place.
- 3) On Friday August 13th, 2021, Gananoque Police conducted a traffic stop on a 50yr old male from Kingston, Ontario. The traffic stop revealed that the male was in possession of unmarked cigarettes. The male was charged under the Tobacco Tax Act for Possession of unmarked Cigarettes.

August 15th, 2021

On July 5th, 2021, The Gananoque Police Service while investigating a traffic stop observed drug paraphernalia within a vehicle and arrested three of the passengers from Kingston. The 40yr old female driver who is a former resident of Gananoque was arrested after officer observed what was believed to be crystal meth within her wallet as she was searching for documentation. The 40yr old female was released unconditionally at the time due to medical attention being required.

A complete search of the vehicle and the involved parties was conducted, and officers ended up seizing a large quantity of crystal methamphetamine, hydromorphone pills, Canadian Currency, a replica handgun, and break in instruments.

Officers attempted to locate the female at the hospital but were informed that she was never admitted as she fled prior to being triaged.

An arrest warrant was issued and on August 15th, 2021 the female was located and held for a bail hearing on the following charges:

Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking a Schedule I Substance Methamphetamine, Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking a Schedule I Substance Morphine, Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose, Possession of Imitation Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose and Possession of Proceeds Obtained by Crime.
