August 21, 2021

On August 21, 2021, officers of the Gananoque Police Service entered into an investigation when Kingston Police Force located and arrested a 31-year-old Kingston area male who was wanted on the strength of an outstanding arrest warrant held by the Gananoque Police Service for the offence of failing to attend for fingerprints. Custody of the male was transferred to the Gananoque Police Service where he was held for a show cause hearing.

August 21, 2021

On August 21, 2021, officers of the Gananoque Police Service entered into an investigation when they were made aware that two youth had left a local youth group home without permission and were considered missing. One of the youths was located and arrested later the same day for breaching the conditions of a Conditional Supervision/Deferred Custody Probation Order. The youth was transferred into a youth detention facility as per an order made by a Youth Court Justice. The second youth was located the following day and returned to the group home. Shortly there after the youth caused damage to property in the group home resulting in police being called. The youth was arrested and charged with two counts of mischief, two counts of Breach of Probation and Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose. He was transported to the Gananoque Police Service and held for a show cause hearing.

August 22, 2021

On August 22, 2021, Officers of the Gananoque Police Service were contacted by Kingston Military Police who had taken custody of a 26-year-old Gananoque man on the strength of an arrest warrant held by the Gananoque Police. The male had previously been released from Court on numerous charges and was required to report to the John Howard Society which he failed to do. Custody was transferred to the Gananoque Police and the male was held for a show cause hearing.
