MEDIA RELEASE

On February 16th, 2020 Gananoque Police Service received a call regarding an intoxicated male attempting to drive. Officers responded and found the male in his vehicle parked outside the business he had just attended. The male showed obvious signs of being intoxicated by alcohol and was subsequently arrested for Impaired Operation of a Conveyance. A breath test was administered, and his blood-alcohol concentration was over twice the legal limit. As a result, the male's license was immediately suspended for 90 days and his vehicle was impounded for 7 days. He was released from police custody by way of an Appearance Notice.
