On June 2, 2019 at 5:25 PM officers respond to a 2-motor vehicle collision on Pine Street, Gananoque. As a result of the investigation, it was determined a 72-year-old female from Gananoque had been operating a motor vehicle and struck an unattended vehicle. The female exhibited signs of impairment and was arrested at the scene and transported to police headquarters. The female provided breath samples and they registered one and a half times the legal limit of blood alcohol concentration permitted while operating a motor vehicle. The female was charged with Impaired Drive and Over 80 and will appear in court to answer to the charges at a later date. Her vehicle was impounded for 7 days and she received an immediate 90-day administrative driver's license suspension.

May 31, 2019 to June 2, 2019 – Targeted Traffic Enforcement

During the 3-day period of May 31 to June 2nd - 27 Highway Traffic Act violations were issued. Charges included, Suspended Driving, Speeding, Expired Validation Tag, No Mudguards, Cell Phone, Seat Belt, Unnecessary Noise, Red Light, Lane Light Violation, and Insurance Act Charges.
