MEDIA RELEASE

March 2, 2020

On March 2, 2020 at 3:21 AM officers while on routine patrol conducted a traffic stop on a driver that was known to be a suspended. Subsequent investigation resulted in the seizure of 3.5 grams of cocaine, scales, packaging material and cutting agent. The male was also under the influence of alcohol. Although his readings did not meet the criteria for a criminal charge, as a result of his license status as a G2 driver he was not permitted to have any alcohol in his system. Open alcohol was located within the vehicle. The 22-year-old male from Leeds and Thousand Island TWP was subsequently arrested and charged with Drive suspended, Possession for the purpose of trafficking – cocaine, and Drive with open container of alcohol. His vehicle was impounded for 7 days. The accused is scheduled to attend Brockville Court at a later date.

March 2, 2020

On March 2, 2020 Gananoque Police responded to a Gananoque group home in relation to a 17-year-old male youth who had left the residence AWOL on February 28, 2020. The youth was currently before the court on several release documents and probation orders from numerous offences over the past two years. Six of the incidents occurred in Gananoque. The accused was subsequently arrested for violating several of his court orders. The accused male youth was held in custody to attend a bail hearing in Brockville for Fail to comply with undertaking x4, Fail to comply with Sentence (Probation) x4, Assault and Utter threats.

March 2, 2020

On March 2, 2020 Officers arrested a 53-year-old male from Kingston on an outstanding arrest warrant out of Kingston for failing to comply with conditions of his probation order. He was taken into custody without incident and turned over to the Kingston Police Service.

March 4, 2020

On March 4, 2020 while officers were on routine patrol, they observed a 23-year-old male from Gananoque known to police and currently before the courts on several charges in relation to failing to comply with his probation. Further investigation revealed he had failed to attend court to answer to those charges and a bench warrant was issued from Brockville Court. Officers arrested the male and he was held in custody on his previous charges as well as charged additionally for Failing to attend court.

March 5, 2020

On March 5, 2020 officers while on routine patrol observed a known 44-year-old female from Gananoque on King Street. A subsequent CPIC check revealed she was currently wanted by Kingston Police Service for failing to comply with conditions of her probation order. The female was arrested without incident and turned over to the custody of Kingston Police Service.

March 5, 2020

On March 5th of 2020, at approximately 10:20pm, Gananoque Police received a call to a construction site located on South Street. An off-site monitoring company had called police to advise that they observed an unknown male inside the jobsite. Officers attended and located a stolen vehicle nearby. Subsequent investigation resulted in officers identifying and locating the lone male responsible for the vehicle theft and entry into the jobsite nearby. He was found to be in possession of material stolen from the jobsite. The male was arrested and returned to police headquarters.

While the male was in police custody his behaviour continued to escalate. It became evident that he was intoxicated by drugs. At one point the male pushed past officers in the cell block area resulting in officers having to physically restrain the male and place him into a restraint wrap for his own safety.

The male was currently bound by conditions of a probation order from non-related incidents. As a result of this incident, the 36-year-old male from Leeds and Thousand Island TWP was charged and held in custody pending a bail hearing. Charges:

Theft of Motor Vehicle - Section 333.1 CC
Theft of Property U\$5000 - Section 334(b) CC
Possession of Property Obtained by Crime U\$5000 - Section 354(1)(a) CC (2 COUNTS)
Probation Order - Non Compliance - Section 733.1(1) CC
Obstruct Peace Officer - Section 129(a) CC
