March 5, 2021

On March 5, 2021 at approx. 9:00PM officers with The Gananoque Police Service were contacted regarding an ongoing neighbor dispute resulting in one neighbor threatening bodily harm on the other neighbor by using a baseball bat. Officers attended, and as a result of the investigation police located and arrested a 68-year-old male from Gananoque for utter threats to cause bodily harm. The male was held in custody and attended a bail court.

March 7, 2021

On March 7, 2021 at approx. 9:30PM officers with The Gananoque Police Service were contacted by concerned citizens regarding 2 intoxicated females that had just left a local establishment and it was believed one of them to be driving impaired. Officers located the vehicle in the south ward at a stop sign, as the passenger was outside the vehicle urinating on the street. Officers conducted a sobriety check on the driver and as a result of the investigation the female driver was arrested for impaired operation of a conveyance. The accused later provided samples of her breath and registered almost twice the legal limit. Police have charged a 62-year-old female from IROQUIS, ON with Impaired Operation of a conveyance and Over 80MGS of a conveyance and she is scheduled to appear in court at a later date. The accused was also issued 90 Drivers License Suspensions and her vehicle as impounded for 7 days.
