MEDIA RELEASE

March 8th, 2021

On March 8th officers responded to a third party request for a well-being check on a female believed to have been the victim of domestic violence. Officers attended and spoke to the female regarding an incident from earlier in the day and statements were taken.

As a result of the investigation, the male suspect was located and apprehended a short time later. A 54 year old Gananoque male was charged with Domestic Assault, Forcible Confinement, Overcome Resistance by Choking and 2 counts of Fail to Comply Probation. The male was lodged in cells and held in custody for a Bail Hearing.

While in custody, the male became increasingly volatile. The male was transported to hospital for assessment before being transported to Brockville Jail. During transport, the male made repeated threats to cause physical harm to others. The male was further charged with 2 counts of Uttering Threats to Cause Bodily Harm.

March 10, 2021

On March 10, 2021 the Gananoque Police Service were contacted as a result of two individuals that had approached an elderly male who was unloading items from his vehicle in an apartment complex parking lot. The two individuals approached the man and snatched a bag of his belongings and fled on foot. Officers responded to the area and spoke to several witnesses who confirmed one of the individuals involved was observed carrying a silver-colored firearm when the offence was committed. A subsequent investigation resulted in officers identifying two youth under the age of 18. Officers located, and arrested the two accused young persons, recovered two silver colored replica firearms and the victim's property at a secondary location. Officers were also able to link two separate mischief calls from the same date to the same two accused persons. In both instances of mischief, they caused damage to residences by defacing the outside of separate homes.

Two youth under the age of 18 have been charged with Robbery, Imitation Weapon related offences, and two counts of Mischief. Both are scheduled to appear in court at a later date.
