On March 11, 2021 at 12:36AM officers while on routine patrol observed a suspicious vehicle that was determined to have been reported stolen out of the City of Kingston on the previous day. Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop, at which time the vehicle fled and failed to stop for officers. Officers terminated the pursuit as a result of the driving exhibited by the driver and public safety concerns. Officers continued to patrol and investigate possible locations the vehicle may have attended and located the vehicle attempting to hide in a private driveway at the jurisdictional border of the City of Kingston and Leeds and Thousand Islands. The vehicle again attempted to flee the area and was contained by officers with Gananoque Police Service and Kingston Police Force. The vehicle became lodged in the septic bed of the residence and the two occupants were taken into custody without further incident. An 18 year female from Kingston was charged with Dangerous Operation of a Conveyance, Flight From Police, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime and Drive Motor Vehicle No License and held for a bail hearing.
