November 5th, 2021

The Gananoque Police responded to a report of a fight in progress at a north ward residence. Police responded and found the fight had ended and the parties had separated. An investigation revealed that a male party had attended the residence of a former girlfriend and forced entry in order to engage the occupants in a fight. The male was removed from the residence by the occupants and the fight was eventually broken up. The male upon departing uttered a threat to return and kill the individuals involved.

As a result a 24-year-old Gananoque man was charged with being unlawfully in a dwelling, two counts of assault, criminal harassment and two counts of uttering threats. The male was held for bail and subsequently released on conditions.

November 6th, 2021

The Gananoque Police executed a warrant on a 25-year-old man from Quebec. The male had been charged by Gananoque Police for driving while prohibited in June, 2021. He subsequently failed to show for his court date and accordingly a warrant was issued for his arrest. On November 6th the male was arrested by Kingston Police and returned to Gananoque where he was held for a bail hearing.

November 7th, 2021

On November 2nd, 2021 the Gananoque Police responded to a report of a domestic assault that occurred at a King Street business. Officers attended and found the male victim still at the scene, but the assailant had departed. On November 7th police arrested and charged a 40-year-old Gananoque woman for one count of assault. The woman was released from custody and will appear in court at a later date.
