MEDIA RELEASE

October 4, 2020

On October 3rd, 2020 the Gananoque Police Service were contacted regarding an ongoing harassment incident spanning the previous 3 1/2 months. Police had previously spoke with the accused cautioning him to cease all contact with the victim. On October 3rd, the victim had received multiple phone calls and 32 messages were left that were derogatory and threatening in nature. Other in person contacts were reported between the accused and the victim that were also unwanted. As a result of the investigation officers arrested a 54-year-old male from Gananoque with criminal harassment. The accused is scheduled to appear in court at a later date.

October 4, 2020

On October 3rd, 2020, the Gananoque Police Service were contacted as a result of the victims property being damaged by the accused. The accused was currently bound by release conditions not to have contact with the victim or attend his location as a result of previous criminal charges. As a result of the investigation it was determined the 24-year-old female accused attended the victim's location, smashed one of the victim's security cameras with a rock, and further threw glass bottles and animal feces over the victim's property. The 24-year-old female from Gananoque was arrested and charged with 2 counts of mischief and 2 counts of fail to comply with release order. The accused is scheduled to appear in court at a later date.
