### **August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021**

On August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 officers responded to a report of three missing youths from a local group home, two of which were on conditions to abide by the rules of the home. Officers observed the youths and a traffic stop was conducted, resulting in the apprehension of the youths. One was returned to the residence and the other two were arrested and taken to the station. Both were charged with Fail to comply with release order and held for show cause hearings.

### **September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021**

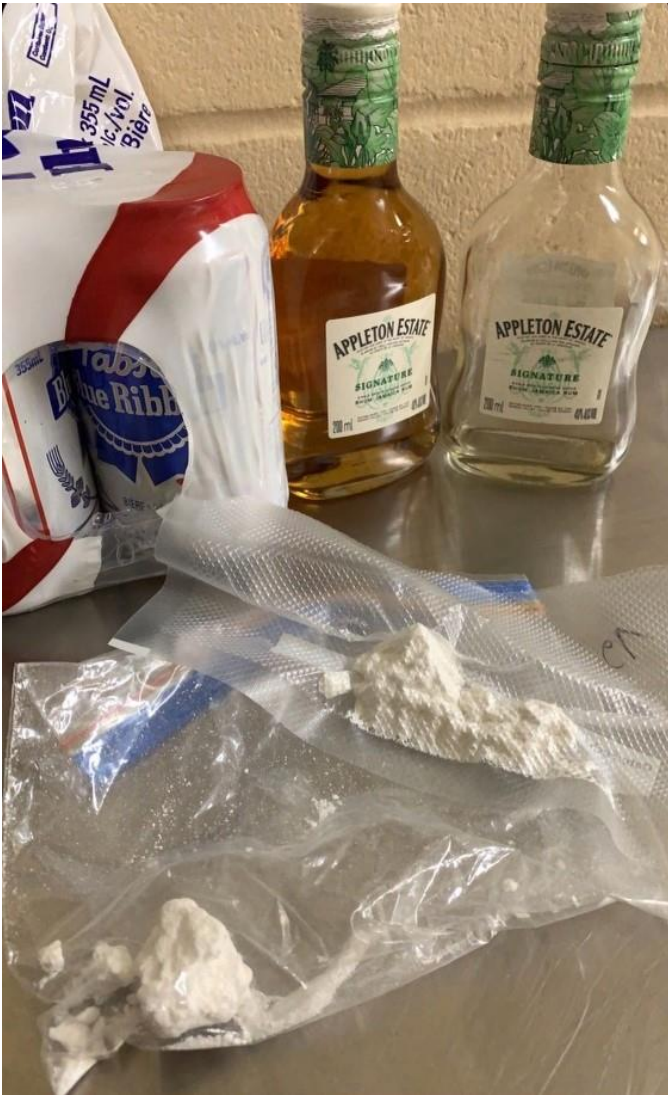
On September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, while on patrol, officers observed a female currently wanted by a neighbouring police service. The 27-year-old female was stopped and arrested on the strength of the warrant and held until Leeds OPP attended to take custody of her.

### **September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

On September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 officers received a report of an assault on a staff member at a local nursing home. An investigation was conducted and information obtained by statements resulted in the arrest of an 88-year-old Gananoque male who was subsequently charged with Assault. The male was released on an Undertaking with conditions, to be seen in court at a later date.

### **September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

On September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle observed at a high rate of speed. Upon approaching the vehicle, numerous alcoholic containers were observed within reach of the driver, resulting in a sobriety check of the driver and a search of the vehicle. As a result of the search, the driver and passenger were placed under arrest. The passenger was released at the roadside unconditionally, and the driver was returned to the station. A 20-year-old Delta man was subsequently charged with Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Cocaine, Fail to Comply with Probation Order, and given a Provincial Offence Notice for Driving Motor Vehicle with Open Contained of Liquor under the Liquor License Act. He was released on an Undertaking with conditions, to be seen in court at a later date.



### **September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

On September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021 in the early morning hours, officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing a passenger failing to wear their seatbelt. Upon approaching the vehicle, open alcohol was observed. Identities were provided by all three occupants with one male providing false information. A cursory search was conducted on the vehicle, which was later towed to the station for a more in-depth search. All three occupants were arrested and returned to the station, due to the findings in the vehicle and two of the males having active warrants. As a result, the charges are as follows:

A 25-year-old male from Kingston, Ontario was charged with: Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Methamphetamine, Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Opioid, Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Cocaine, Possession of a Schedule III Substance, Fail to Comply with Probation Order, Driving while Under Suspension.

A 40-year-old female from Kingston, Ontario was charged with: Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Methamphetamine, Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Opioid, Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Cocaine, Possession of a Schedule III Substance,

A 43-year-old male from Kingston, Ontario was charged with: Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Methamphetamine, Possession of a Schedule I Substance – Opioid, Possession of a Schedule I Substance –

Cocaine, Possession of a Schedule III Substance, Failure to Comply with Release Order, Personation with Intent to Avoid Arrest, Prosecution, or Obstruct Justice, Obstruct Peace Officer.

All persons were released on an Undertaking with extensive conditions, and one male who had outstanding warrants with Kingston Police Force, was turned over to their care.
